## Choosing a HUSKY Health Plan and Provider

### Choosing a health care option

HUSKY is Connecticut's health insurance program for kids and families. When you join HUSKY, you must either:

Choose a health care plan. If you choose a health plan, you will get your health care from the doctors, hospitals, clinics and others that participate in the particular plan. Sometimes you have to ask your health plan to ok your doctor visits or medicine.

- Pick a plan that has the doctors, hospitals, clinics and specialists that you go to now or would like to go to.

OR

If you are a HUSKY A member, you can also choose HUSKY Primary Care, depending on where you live in Connecticut. Choose the doctor who provides you and/or your children with basic (primary) care, such as a family doctor or pediatrician. This doctor oversees your care and oks visits to other doctors or medicine, instead of a health plan. You can sign up for HUSKY Primary care at 1-877-CTHUSKY (1-877-284-8759).

### Choosing a primary care provider

You need to choose a doctor to be your “primary care provider”. Your primary care provider will get to know you and your family and take care of your health needs. This doctor helps decide if you need to go to a specialist, get medicine, or go to the hospital. Your health plan can help you find a primary care doctor.
